Advanced Diploma in Arabic & Translation

There will be four written papers for Adv. Diploma in Arabic & Translation, each carrying 80 marks and an oral examination of 100 marks according to the following scheme:

Paper 1	A survey of Arabic Literature from Pre-Islamic upto the Modern period
Paper 2	Modern Prose & Poetry
Paper 3	Rhetorics, Composition & Dialogue
Paper 4 (Part- I)	Translation from Arabic into English & vice-versa
Paper 4 (Part – II)	Oral Examination

Note:

- Twenty marks for internal assessment to be set aside for each written paper.
- The medium of instruction will be Arabic & English.

Advanced Diploma in Arabic & Translation

Paper 1: A survey of Arabic Literature from Pre-Islamic upto the Modern period

Beside a survey of Arabic literature from the Pre-Islamic upto the modern period one has to study especially the following poets, prose-writers and their literary works:

- (b) Magāmāt: Al-Ĥarīri & al-Hamdāni
- (c) Poetry & eminent poets: Abu Tammām, al-Bukhtari, al-Mutanabbi & al-Ma'arri
- (d) Poetry of the Muslim Spain
