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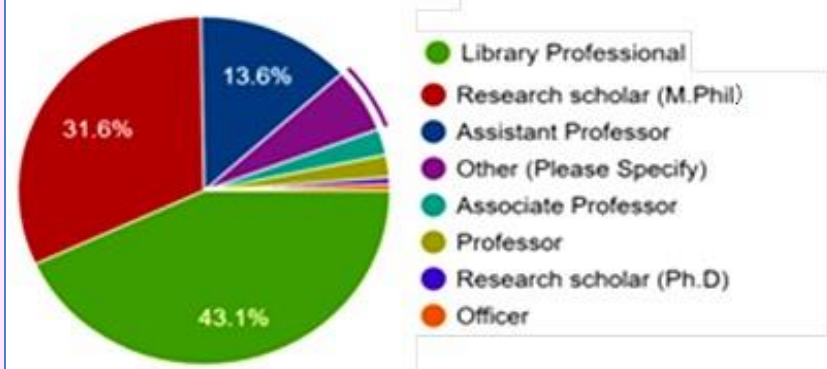

First VBLN National Webinar - 2020

In light of the rapidly evolving Covid-19 situation, following the directives of Government of India and also subsequent notifications by the University authority to keep library premises closed until further notice. The University Librarian (Acting) Dr Nimai Chand Saha took innovative step which is first of its kind in the history of Visva-Bharati Library Network to organize eleven days National Webinar during 02-12 May, 2020. Dr Nimai Chand Saha, University Librarian (Acting) was the Organizing Secretary and Assistant Librarians Sri Ajay Kumar Sharma and Sri Sujit Kujur acted as Assistant Organizing Secretary, hosted the Webinar on free version Cisco Webex Meeting platform with joining capacity only 100 candidates in each session.

This Webinar was highly appreciated where three hundred and thirty-two (332) candidates registered (https://docs.google.com/forms/d/1voPTx-LVO2m_J0IfsEJhMN3pLYbrv1PHh3s2A_RSIE/edit) from the different parts of India within 48hrs of opening of registration. This is to be noted that due to the limitation of the free version of Cisco Webex Meeting platform only 100 participants were accommodated. Therefore, to control the rush registration had to close three days before the webinar.

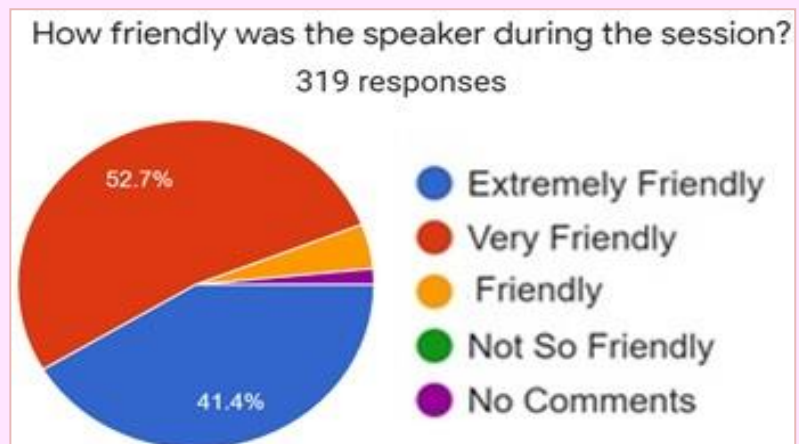

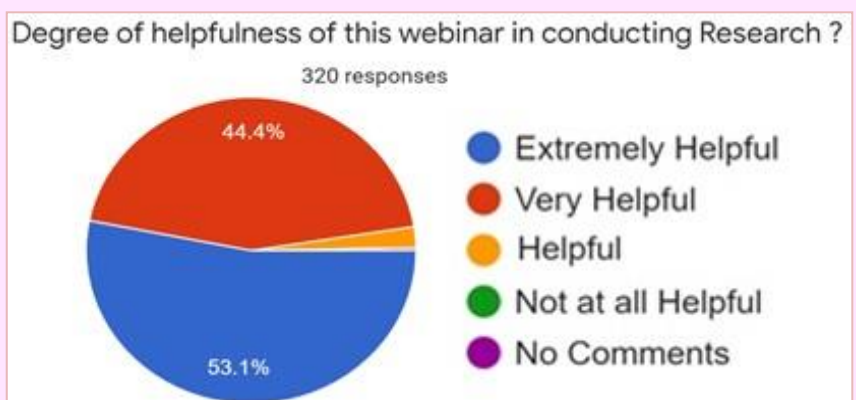
After the successful completion of the webinar participation certificates were sent to the participants through mail based on their interaction, feedback and others. Certificate sent to the speakers of the Webinar too through mail. The certificates have been generated by using software which was highly appreciated by the participants.

On the last day, feedback form has been generated by using Google Form (<https://docs.google.com/forms/d/1UvQijyAppRzOISmQ70p5EZqx-KQ5JBjkVSOa7J1LpuA/edit>) and has been sent to the candidates through mail. The response was very positive and encouraging. Most of the participants requested to organize similar kinds of webinar more and more in near future. Some of the feedbacks are shown graphically below:



From the pie charts it is seen that, more than 92% of the respondents have rated the event as excellent and very good; the speakers were friendly during interactive session; this event will help them to conduct smooth academic and research activities.

Due to the limitation of the free version of the software (100 only) it was not possible to accommodate all the registered candidates to join in a particular session.



More than 200 candidates intended to join in each of the session. To address the requests of the candidates not able to joined, as an alternative VBLN opened a YouTube channel and uploaded videos of all the sessions and shared the channel link (https://www.youtube.com/channel/UCfv9MHVyWy0b0g_rcOFaHpw) which is now available to view to the global level. Further, as requested PDF files of all the presentations have been sent to the participants through mail. Both the initiatives have been appreciated by the participants and their comments through mail and chats were also very signing and satisfactory. Participants have requested to arrange similar events with more intake capacity and emerging themes for conducting research in current contexts.

On the last day of the Webinar, University Librarian (Acting) has extended warm thanks to all the participants for bare with the adverse situation particularly last two-days due to technical disturbances and request to join in the future events. Finally, VBLN would like to record its deep sense of gratitude to the Visva-Bharati authority for allowing and inspiring to organize such a pertinent and successful event.

SOME RECENT ACTIVITIES:

- **Webinar:** Series of eleven lectures have been arranged through Webinar during 02 -12 May 2020, as noted in the main text.
- **COVID19:**
 - **Uninterrupted learning materials:** VBLN is much concern to provide study materials among the VB fraternity even in this lockdown period due to emerging outbreaks of novel Corona virus and spread of COVID 19. Therefore, to continue uninterrupted study and research work, library has already sent its appeal to the e-publishers/aggregators to offer their e-resources (which we have purchased or subscribed) to access through ID and password till 30 June 2020, as a special measure. On our request many e-resource publishers / providers have offered some of their e-resources for free access of full-texts and research tools for VB fraternity. Accordingly, the same has been circulated along with the Open Access Resources and Publishers’ offer of Free Access among the target groups through university website, E-mail, and WhatsApp vide Memo No. CL/004/2020-21/(GNet), CL/005/2020-21/(GNet), dated 31 May 2020.
 - **Creation WhatsApp group:** In addition to E-mail, Face book, considering the current situation VBLN has decided to create separate WhatsApp group for the Officers to keep them appraise with the library services, activities, notification of the University Administration and UGC. As we know, nowadays WhatsApp is the very handy and mostly used social network by the community.
 - **Creation YouTube Channel:** Considering the growing demands of the recently organized lecture sessions through the webinar, VBLN has decided to create separate channel of YouTube through which intending candidates of Visva-Bharati and any one from India and abroad may view the videos for conducting smooth research and academics activities. The Link is : https://www.youtube.com/channel/UCfv9MHVyWy0b0g_rcOFaHpw. All are requested to subscribe, like the channel as well as post comments for its betterment.
- **Documents / Article Delivery Services:** During the month 19 no. of soft copies of the articles have been collected and delivered through mail as requested by the academics/scholars.
- **Exhibition and Celebration of Important Days:** No exhibition and celebration of important days has arranged due to Lockdown.
- **Similarity Checking Through URKUND Software:** On request from the academics 27 articles/Files have been checked through URKUND software and report has been forwarded through mail.

- **Cleaning & washing and air-passing in the library stack:** considering the fate of the valuable print collections of the library, Central Library and most of the Bhavana Libraries have been opened and followed cleaning & washing of the library premises, including toilets. As we know, the library print collections are always need to have fresh air with normal temperature. But, due to lockdown it remains lock for more than two months which is unhealthy for the library print collections. To address the issue, stack room has also been opened, cleaned and passed the air. The activities have been done maintaining social distancing and other issues relating to Covid-19. If lockdown is continuing, it is decided that after every 10-12 days libraries are to be opened and repeat the cleaning & washing activities for the safety of library print resources. Naphthalene will be used in the library stack as primary measure. Also, with the kind assistance of University Engineer, Central Library has checked its entire electric connectivity to avoid any untoward situation.
- **New Additions (Books) during the Month:** Not possible due to Lockdown.
- **Remote Access Login/Password:** On request from the academics 17 new Remote Access including Discovery Services have been opened and on request around 29 existing expired accounts have been renewed for their accessibility. The name of the Remote Access platform is OpenAthens from the Ebsco Information Services.
