Second VBLN National Webinar - 2020

In light of the current pandemic due to covid-19, following the directives of Government of India and also subsequent notifications by the University authority, Visva-Bharati Library Network (VBLN) has taken several initiatives to keep update and to assist academics for the Research and Academic activities as far as practicable. As part of the initiatives and based on the feedback from the participants of 1st VBLN National Webinar, VBLN under the leadership of University Librarian (Acting), has organized 2nd National Webinar during 16-18, 22-27 & 29 June 2020. Dr Nimai Chand Saha, University Librarian (Acting) was the Organizing Secretary and Dr Tapas Kumar Das, Deputy Librarian and Dr Sanat Kumar Bhattacharya, Assistant Librarian acted as Assistant Organizing Secretary for hosting the Webinar on Cisco Webex Meeting platform with joining capacity 1000 candidates in each session.

This Webinar was highly appreciated where five hundred and forty (540) candidates registered through the link: <https://forms.gle/xgGMJtHMuq5e54Yg6> from the 26 states of India. Maximum participants were from West Bengal (68.15%), from Maharashtra (5.93%), from Jharkhand (5%), Uttar Pradesh (4.81), Assam, Delhi & Odisha (1.67%); Madhyapradesh (1.48%) and Tamilnadu (1.11%). Around 200 candidates have joined in each of the session.

Registration was open for all till 16th June Morning (9 am), i.e. just before the starting of the first session.

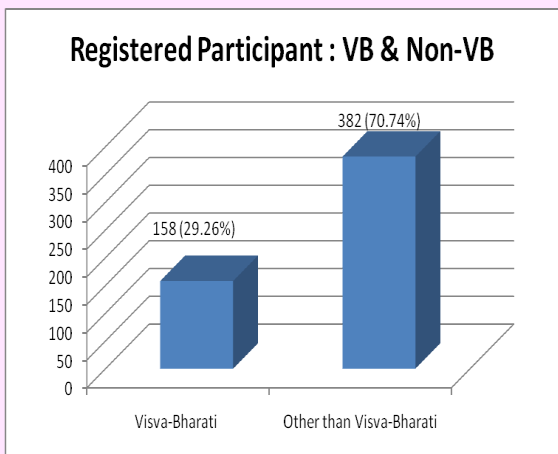

Rest of the resource persons were the Library Officers from Visva-Bharati Library Network (VBLN) except one Dr Subhashree Nag from Clarivate Analytics presented "EndNote: a reference management tools" (27/06) in absence of Mr Sujit Kujur due to his illness.

Dr Koushik Ghosh presented INFLIBNET in Accelerating Research Activities (17/06); Dr Partha Pratim Roy presented Library and Community Development: Tagorean Perspective (18/06); Sri Ramprasad Mazumdar presented Guidelines and Experiences on Dspace (22/06); Ms. Sabahat Nausheen presented Role of Libraries in

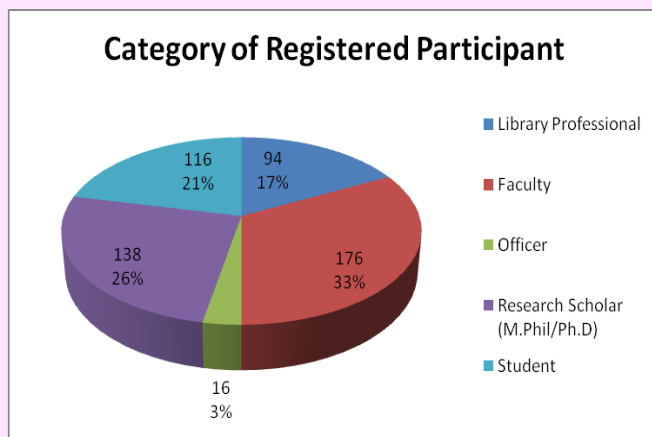
Ranking and Accreditation of the Institutions (23/06); Dr Sanat Bhattacharya presented Web-based sources of resources for knowledge enhancement (24/06). Dr Tapas Kumar Das presented JASP: a fresh way to do statistics (25/06). Sri Ajay Kumar Sharma presented Google Tools for Teacher (26/06) and Dr Nimai Chand Saha presented Raxter and Grammarly as Research Tools (29/06).

After the successful completion of the webinar certificates have been sent to the registered participants through mail based on their interaction, feedback and others. Certificate sent to the speakers of the Webinar too through mail. The certificates have been generated by using software which was highly appreciated by the participants and bearing no cost.

On the last day, feedback form has been generated by using Google Form <https://forms.gle/xUj5sV6xr67BMLAt9> and has been disseminated among the participants through mail. The response was very positive and encouraging. Most of the participants requested to organize similar kinds of webinar more and more in near future. 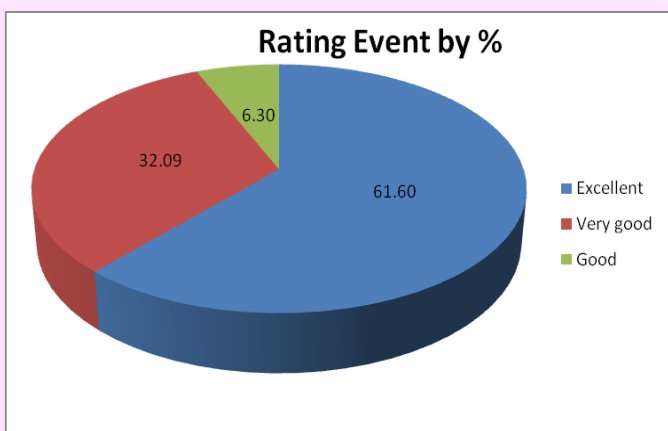


From the above presentation it is seen that, out of total participants, from Visva-Bharati community 29.26 % and rest are from 70.74 % other than VB community.

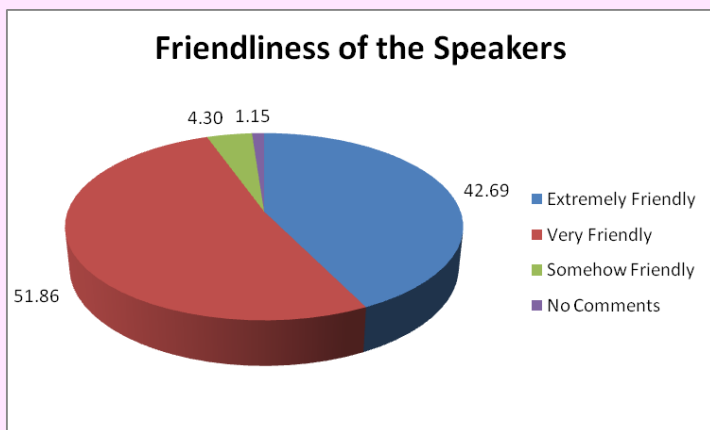


From the above it is seen that, among the total number of participants, 33 % are from faculty members; 26 % are from scholars; 21% from students; 17 % from library professionals and rest 3% from officers.

It is seen from the above pie chart that, more than 93% of the participants marked the entire event as Excellent and Very Good.



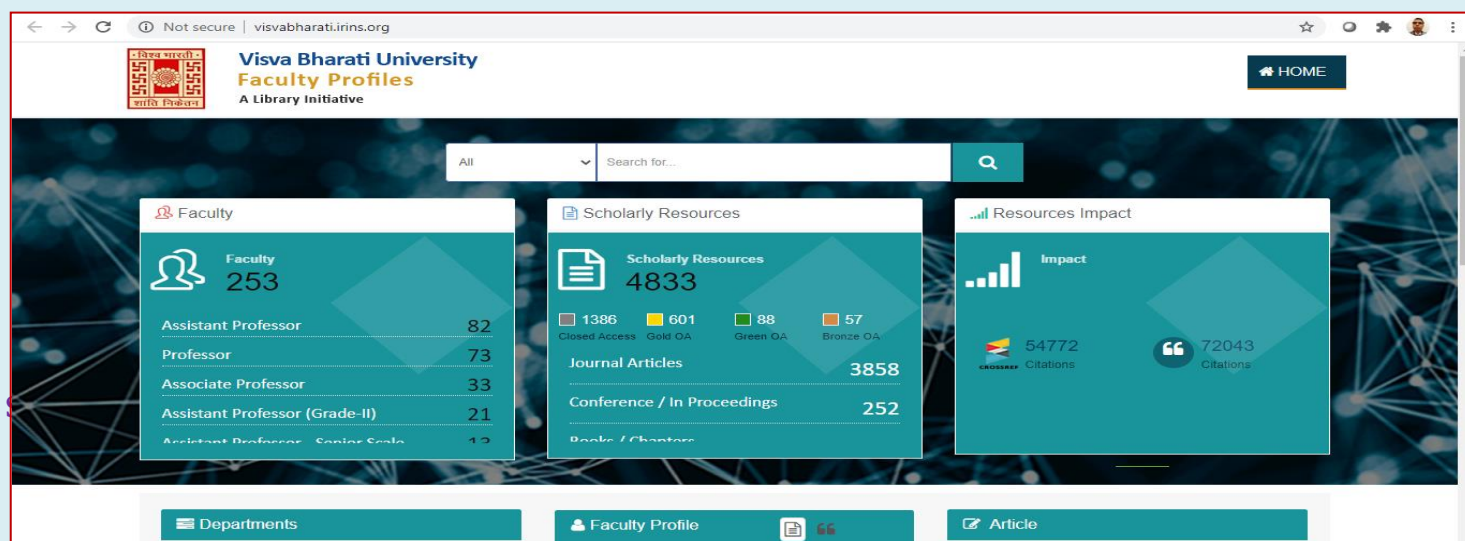
There was an option to know from the participants about the friendliness of the speaker in each session:

SOME RECENT ACTIVITIES:

- **Webinar: as instructed by UGC and University authority, a series of 5 lectures under the caption “3rd VBLN National Webinar” on “Gandhiji” has been arranged during 31 July and 03-04 August 2020. Detailed information will be placed in the next issue of the Newsletter.**
- **Special session on Vidwan database among the faculty members:** To take part in VIDWAN and linking with IRINS as well as to update the database of VIDWAN Central Library has circulate the second notice through university website, mail and WhatsApp group vide memo no. Memo No. CL/48/2020-21/(GNet) and Date: 12 July 2020. In addition to the notification, as follow-up action based on discussion in the meeting on NAAC at Bangladesh Bhavana, Visva-Bharati on 20 July 2020 special awareness program has been conducted to insist academics to participate in the Vidwan Expert database and subsequent linking with the Indian Research Information Network System (IRINS). Considering the issues social distancing it was decided to invite sample representative of faculties from each department under the Bhavana who will help to other colleagues in the department. The special drive has been arranged as below;
22.07.2020- Faculties of Vinaya-Bhavana- No of participants- 07
24.07.2020- Faculties of PSB- No of participants- 11
27.07.2020- Faculties of Vidya-Bhavana- No of participants- 17
28.07.2020- Faculties of Bhasha and Sangit-Bhavana- No of participants- 24
30.07.2020- Faculties of PSV and Kala-Bhavana - No of participants- 18

It is fact that this program is of immense help to faculty members for registration and at present the total registration is around 225. The special awareness program for faculties of Siksha Bhavana will be arranged very soon.

- **Creation YouTube Channel:** Considering the growing demands of the recently organized lecture sessions through the webinar, VBLN has created its YouTube channel through which intending candidates of Visva-Bharati and any one from India and abroad may view the videos for conducting smooth research and academics activities. Total 42 videos are available in the link.
- **Documents / Article Delivery Services:** During the month 15 no. of soft copies of the articles have been collected and delivered through mail as requested by the academics/scholars.
- **Exhibition and Celebration of Important Days:** No exhibition and celebration of important days has arranged due to Lockdown.
- **Similarity Checking Through URKUND Software:** On request from the academics 19 articles/Files have been checked through URKUND software and report has been forwarded through mail.
- **Online Ph.D. Open Viva Voce:** as discussed in a meeting and as instructed by the authority, VBLN has take-up the initiative to offer necessary technical-support for arranging Online Ph.D. Open Viva Voce on different dates. Altogether, four candidates (Cultural Studies (01, 01/07), Hindi (02, 27/07) and Siksha Bhavna (Zoology-01, 24/07) have appeared in the online viva to complete the Ph.D. program in this pandemic days when viva in physical mode is not possible.
- **Remote Access Login/Password:** On request from the academics 06 new Remote Access including Discovery Services have been opened and on request around 21 existing expired accounts have been renewed for their accessibility. The name of the Remote Access platform is OpenAthens from the Ebsco Information Services.

The methodology draws from the overall recommendations broad understanding arrived at by a Core Committee set up by MHRD, to identify the broad parameters for ranking various universities and institutions. The parameters broadly cover “Teaching, Learning and Resources,” “Research and Professional Practices,” “Graduation Outcomes,” “Outreach and Inclusivity,” and “Perception”.

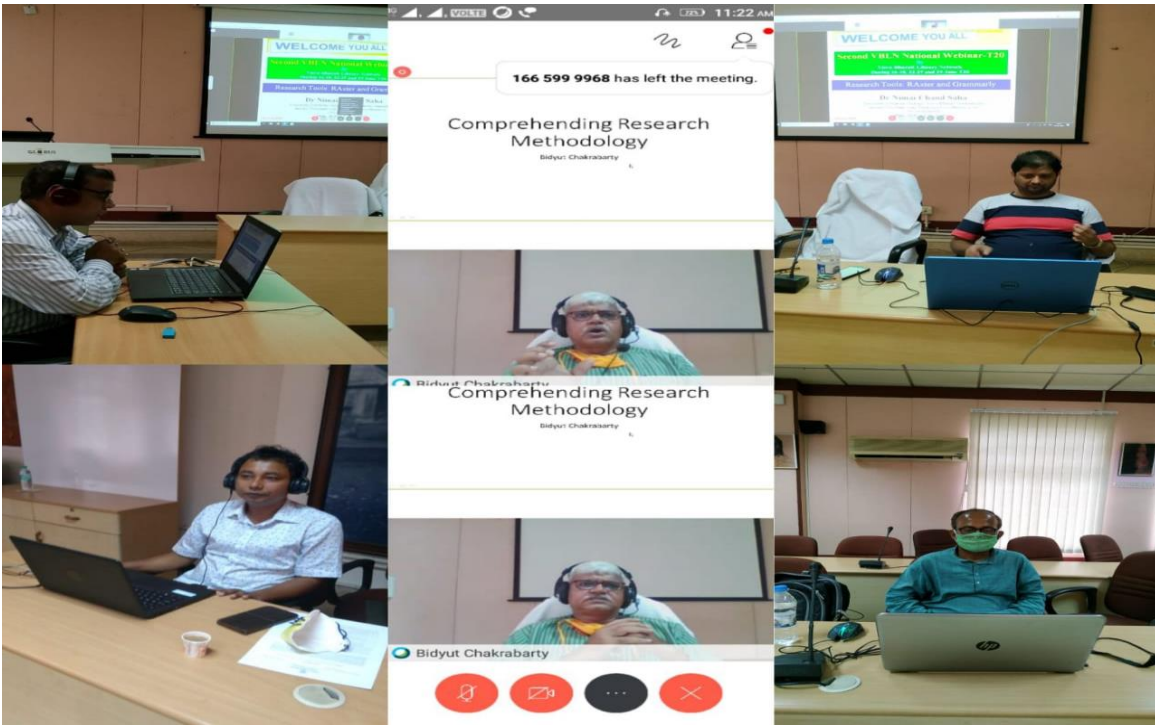
