Reference Services at Visva-Bharati Central Library

The Reference Section of Visva-Bharati Central Library provides services to the end users on a fast mode.

Location: Located at the entrance of the Central Library. The Section can accommodate more than 30 users at a time.

Staff: Three library personnel: One Assistant Librarian and two Semi-Professional Assistants serve in the Section. Besides meeting users' reference requirements, the professionals also involve in user education activities particularly for proper utilisation of the resources.

Users Frequency: On an average 40 users per day.

Collection: The Section holds more than 26,000 reference resources including very good number of encyclopedias, dictionaries, government publications, theses, census reports, yearbooks, guide books, Visva-Bharati publications, atlas, maps, etc. on various subject domains. Reference sources on philosophy and religion, social science, language of Indian and foreign origin, subject specific encyclopedias like economics, physical education, fine arts are frequently used.

Special Demands: Books on and by Rabindranath Tagore are of most demanding nature. Special collection on Birbhum district, English literature and Panjika (Bengali Almanac) are held in high demand.

Users: All the registered members of Visva-Bharati Library Network can avail the services provided by this section. The Library also permits visiting scholars / temporary users to use resources, generally for a day. However extension is provided for.

Uses: In the academic session 2013-14, the Section served 2,404 users (1316 student, 614 scholars, 36 teachers, 9 staffs and 267 others excluding temporary users). Temporary users are mostly faculty and research scholars from other academic institutions.

Services:

- ✓ **Reading Facility:** 30 users are accommodated at a time with individual seating arrangements. The service is not restricted to the collection at Reference Section alone. Books from stacks may also be allowed with due permission. Personal books may be allowed conditionally.
- ✓ **Temporary Membership.** Temporary members / users are allowed to use Reading Room, Reference Section and Periodical Section. Photocopying and access to online resources are extended to them. They can seek transfer of books from stack to Reference Section for study but borrowing / home lending is not allowed.
- ✓ **Photocopy:** Reference materials (some are restricted) are allowed for the photocopying as per library rules i.e. 20 pages per book per users per day. In the academic session 2013-14, 2723 pages of books were photocopied.
- ✓ **E-Content/ Digitization:** Scanning or digitization by own camera is conditionally allowed. Two scanners are provided for self-scanning.
- ✓ **Inter Library Loan (ILL):** Demands of books / journals which are not in the holdings of Visva-Bharati Library system can be procured through Inter Library Loan (ILL).
- ✓ **Referral Services:** If the required reference source is not available in its own collection, Referral Service is provided whereby the users to the location of the resources.
- ✓ **Document Delivery Services (DDS):** When required resources are not available in the library collection, efforts are made to obtain them from publishers / forums / university or institute libraries.
- ✓ **Request Modes:** Mode of receiving request / query by all means (e-mails, letters, phones, etc.) are entertained.
- ✓ **Questionnaire Service:** Questionnaires from various institutes, researchers, etc. are filled up by the Reference Section.
- ✓ **Feedback:** Collects and maintains feedback on the Section.

Do you know ...?

The Library offers various resources and services to the end-users. This feature will highlight one such in each of its issues. This issue focuses on the Indiastat.com of Visva-Bharati Library network.

Indiastat.com

Indiastat.com, an initiative of Datanet India Pvt. Ltd. was launched on 14 November, 2000. It is a gateway to comprehensive and authentic socio-economic information related to India. This web portal provides well compiled and ready to use India-specific socio-economic statistical information culled out from various authentic secondary sources. Indiastat.com is a cluster of 56 sites including 19 sector specific and 31 India/State/UTs specific sites, and 6 Regional sites.

Over half-a-million pages of statistical data have been qualitatively analyzed, condensed and presented in a user-friendly format on the portal. The socio-economic statistical data has been categorized in more than 35 classifications and further sub-divided into various sub-categories. This exhaustive compilation of data can easily be accessed in three or four clicks and can be searched for any fact or figure. The data can be downloaded in MS-Excel/HTML formats.

Researchers, students and faculty of Visva-Bharati can easily access the database covering all major parameters for research, study, review and reference purposes. Information available online can be used by them as per their need and discretion. With over 5,00,000 comprehensive pages on the net, the site covers wide ranging topics like agriculture, demographics, market forecast, health, media, economy, crime, social welfare etc.

Visva-Bharati can access indiastat.com by IP login which implies that you are on the university LAN while you log in.

NB: a) The access is restricted a user at a time. In case you fail to get access, kindly wait for your turn. b) Log –in is required for downloading only.

How to start

Users can start navigating for data available on the site through any of the following three different ways:

- By clicking on IP Login on the toolbar – at home page (indiastat.com) (Log –in is required only if you download)
- By navigating the site – through the section “Statistical Information” available on the left panel on its home page, and
- By searching the data on site – through the “Search” box given on its home page.

Where to login

It is advisable to start navigating the site by logging-in as suggested below:

Click on the IP Login option (shown prominently on the tool bar) on home page, as shown below:



Navigation for data

- Whether logged in or not, click the requisite Data Category, under “Statistical Information” shown on the left panel.
- You get on screen the alphabetical list of its sub-categories. Clicking a sub-category will lead you to a further sub-category or to the list of data table headings pertaining to the sub-category clicked.
- The page showing data table heading shows you data at India level or State-wise or Region-wise consolidated data. Click on any State/ Union Territory/ Region name, would further take you to the data table listing page, for the clicked State/Union Territory. Region, under the said heading.
- Click the table heading to view the data table that will be shown in a separate window.
- In case not logged in, the following window would appear asking you to log in – thru home page.



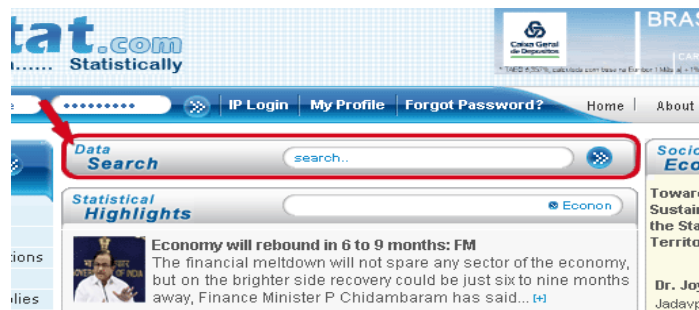
- Once the data table is displayed, you may download the data table in MS-Excel, MS-Word or HTML format and/or print the table, subject to the rights assigned with your access.

Searching the data available on site

You can also search the data available on site thru the “Search” box shown prominently below the top tool bar.

The data available, relating to the keyword or phrase submitted by you would appear as search result in the form of a list of data table headings.

You may click any table heading to view the data by following the instruction given in Para ‘Navigating for Data’ above.
