Indiastat

Indiastat.com, an initiative of Datanet India Pvt. Ltd. was established as an IT-enabled private limited company in February 2000 to provide socio-economic information service. Its first web site www.indiastat.com was inaugurated by the Minister of State, Dept. of Statistics, Planning and Public Grievances, Govt. of India, **Shri Arun Shourie** at New Delhi launched on 14th November 2000. Indiastat.com serves with authentic and provides most comprehensive compilation of secondary level socio-economic statistical information about India and its states on various socio-economic parameters. These parameters are: General Info, Demographics, Economy, Agriculture, Civil Supplies and Consumer Affairs, Environment and Forest, Industries, Infrastructure, Companies, Education, Health, Housing, Labour & Workforce, Polity, Media, Insurance, Tourism, Crime & Law, Social Welfare & Developmental Schemes etc.

Indiastat.com provides secondary level socio-economic statistical information about India, its states, regions and sector. Indiastat.com is a cluster of 56 associate websites wherein 19 websites are sector-specific, 6 are regional websites and 31 websites are state-specific. Subscribing Indiastat.com will give an automatic access of its 56 associate sites. Indiastat.com contains all the statistical information sites just for an ease of navigation. If require, subscription to these associates can also be taken separately.

The compiled data can easily be accessed in three or four clicks and can be searched for any fact or figure. The data can be downloaded in MS-Excel/HTML formats. Researchers, students and faculty of Visva-Bharati can easily access the database covering all major parameters for research, study, review and reference purposes through URL of this site indiastat.com. One can access indiastat.com by IP login which implies that he/she is accessing through the university LAN.

How to start - Users can start navigating for data available on the site through any of the following three different ways:

- By clicking on IP Login on the toolbar – at home page (indiastat.com) (Log-in is required only if you download)
- By navigating the site – through the section “Statistical Information” available on the left panel on its home page, and
- By searching the data on site – through the “Search” box given on its home page.

Where to login - It is advisable to start navigating the site by logging-in as suggested below:

Click on the IP Login option (shown prominently on the tool bar) on home page.



Navigation for data

- Whether logged in or not, click the requisite Data Category, under “Socio-Economic Statistical Information about India” shown on the panel.
- One can find on screen the alphabetical list of its sub-categories. Clicking a sub-category will lead user to a further sub-category or to the list of data table headings pertaining to the sub-category clicked.
- The page showing data table heading shows data at India level or State State/ Union Territory/ Region name, for the clicked State/Union Territory. Region, under the said heading.
- Click the table heading to view the data table that will be shown in a separate window.
- In case not logged in, the following window would appear asking user to log in –thru home page.
- Once the data table is displayed, user may download the data table in MS Word or HTML format and/or print the table, subject to the rights assigned with the user access.

Searching the data available on site

- One can also search the data available on site thru the “Data Search” box shown prominently below the top toolbar.
- The data available, relating to the keyword or phrase submitted by user would appear as search result in the form of a list of data table headings.
- User may click any table heading to view the data by following the instruction given in Para ‘How to navigating the site for data’ above.
