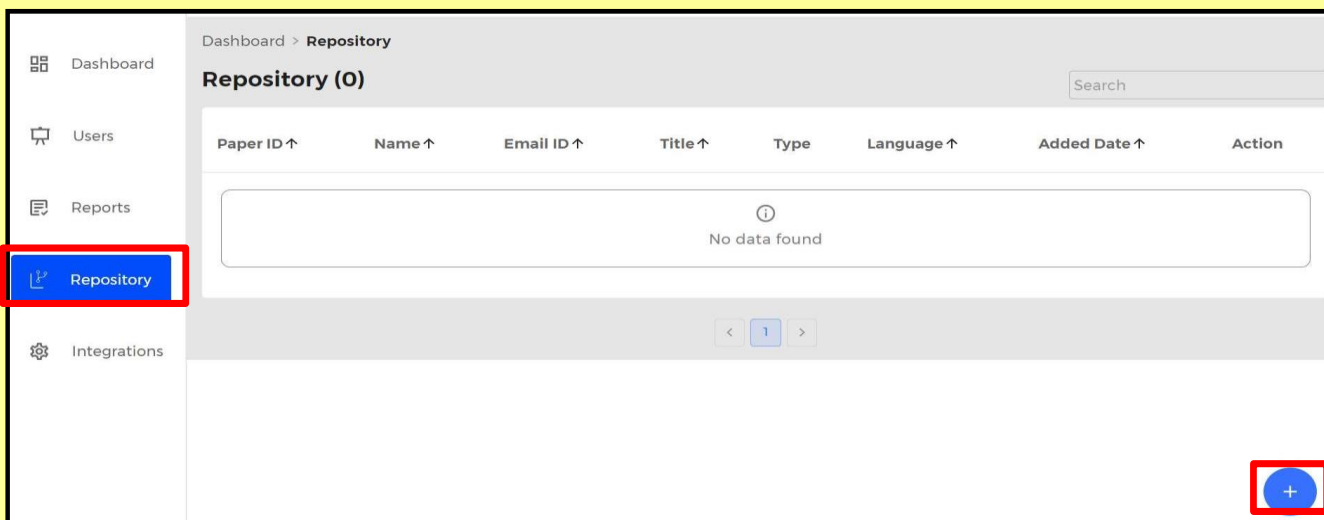

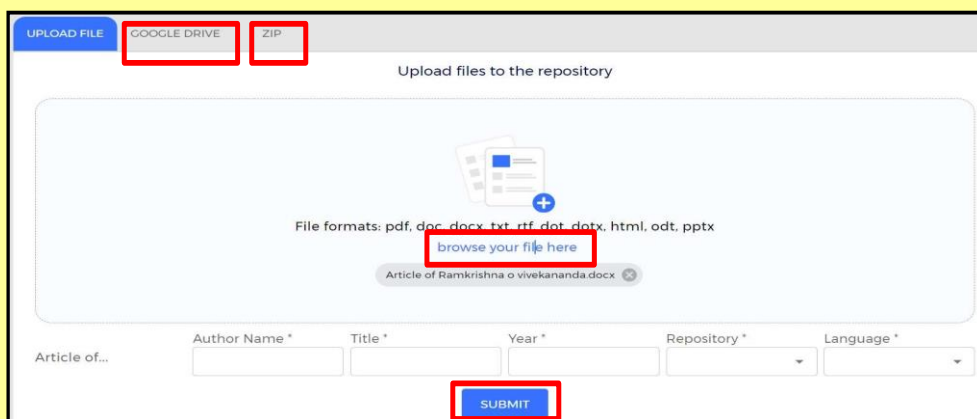
Repository: Users can save previous years or old files in the repository to compare current year documents and to avoid duplication within the Institutions.

Step3: click on “browse your file here” and upload single file, multiple files, zip folder or file from the google drive

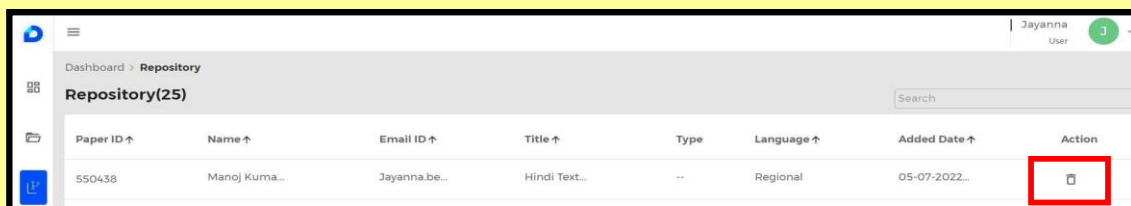


Enter the Author name, title, year, Repository type (Institution/Global), language (English/Non-English) Click on “SUBMIT” to upload the files.

The files will be permanently removed from the repository within 24 hour.

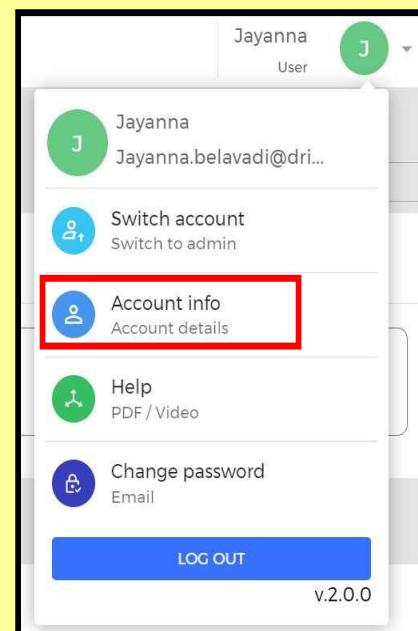
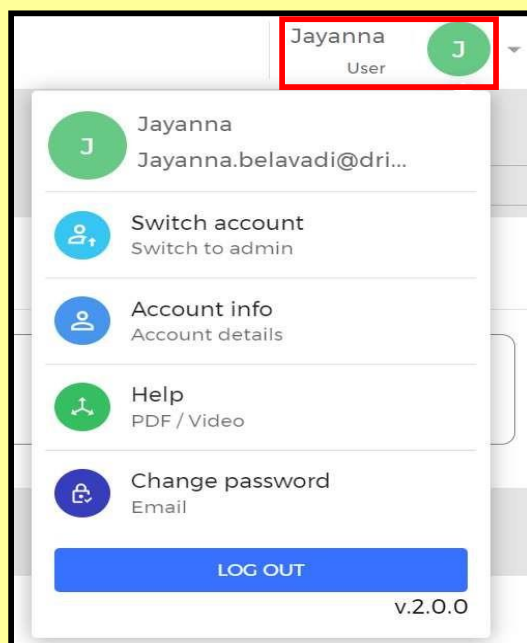


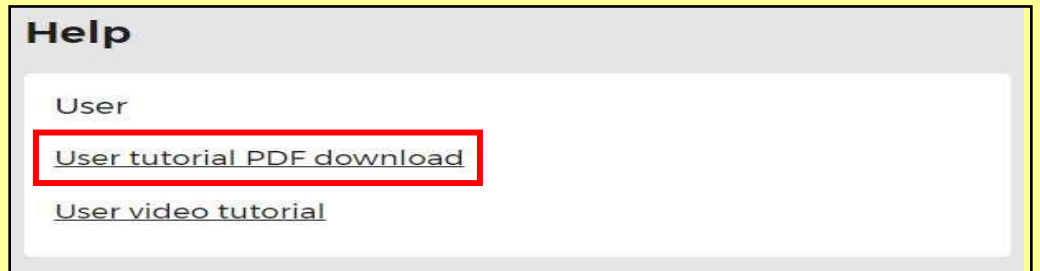
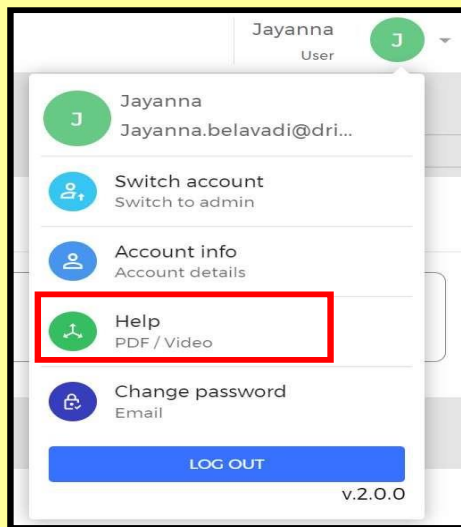
User Profile:

Click on the profile, left side top corner and Log out.

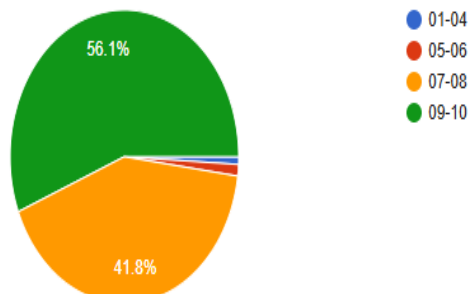

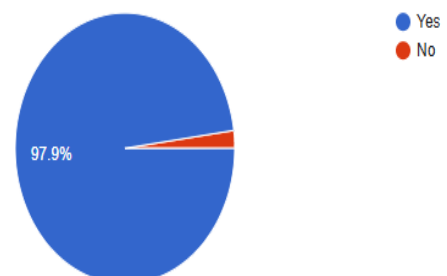
How do you rate (overall) the RPE (Paper -IV) course - 2024 conducted by the Library
