The Central Library and its twelve Sectional/Departmental Libraries have received P.C. Printer, Library software etc. All Libraries have Internet, On-line searching, e-mail facilities. Creation of library databases is going on in the Central Library by using internal manpower resources. Retrospective conversion of existing manual catalogue is also going on by deploying the internal manpower. Computers and library software LIBSYS Unicode are used for the purposes of Acquisition of library documents, e.g. books and journals; Cataloguing; Serial control; Membership registration, etc. About 30,000 titles of documents (bearing 35,000 individual accession numbers) are entered up till now in library catalogue databases.
