12. Publication: Library Bulletin – 'Current periodicals-2007' for subscribed Journals.
13. Library Automation: Visva-Bharati Library (Central Library and all Sectional Libraries) has been connected with the Gitanjali Net, the University Campus wide Network. Library has 42 PCs, 22 printers for its Central Library and Sectional Library use. Library has been provided services and facilities of Internet, e-book browsing, e-journal browsing, on-line searching, e-mail facilities, etc. for its users and library management purposes. The Library software LibSys (Unicode compliant) is used for the housekeeping purposes and daily library operation. Main library housekeeping works include: Acquisition of library documents, cataloguing; Serial control, Circulation, OPAC etc. Retro conversion from manual catalogue is going on by deploying internal manpower resources of Central Library. Visva-Bharati Library catalogue database holds 96098 titles of documents containing 171168 individual accession numbers including 43000 bound volumes of journals and 866 theses.

Under this project we have completed scanning and digitizing work of 5200 titles of old Central Library documents containing 26 lakhs pages. We have already received 102 DVDs. Metadata of digitized documents are being made and are available for the users. This information is available in library home page. CDAC, Kolkata the operator of this project, has informed us that the first phase work has completed and they are waiting for sanction from Government to start the second phase work. Question papers of 2005-06 have already been digitized and will available for the use of the students through LAN. Digitization of question paper of 2006-07 is in progress
