12. Library Digitization: **Central library**

#### **Library Automation:**

Visva-Bharati Library has connected with the Gitanjali Net (INFLIBNET), the University Campus wide Network. Library has 52 PCs, 22 printers for its Central Library and 12 Sectional Libraries. Library offers services and facilities to its users for e-book browsing, e-journal browsing, on-line searching, e-mail facilities, etc. For library management purposes, library software LibSys (Unicode compliant) is being used. Main library housekeeping works and daily library operation i.e. Acquisition of library documents, Cataloguing, Serial control, Circulation, OPAC, etc. are going on smoothly. Retro conversion from manual catalogue is going on by deploying internal manpower as well as External Agencies and now available on Intranet throughout campus. It is expected that the full library catalogue database will be available on Web very soon. Presently, Visva-Bharati Library catalogue database holds 490325 titles of documents containing 567328 individual accession numbers including 43000 bound volumes of journals and 866 theses. Status of ‘Current Periodicals-2008’ containing 229 titles is to be found through library home page. In addition, 817 titles of E-books are

linked with the library home page for browsing through out the campus which were procured by the library from the world famous E-publishers (Elsevier, Cambridge Online and Sage).

### **Library Digitization:**

Under the 'Mega Digital Library project of India' Central Library has completed scanning and digitizing work of 5200 titles of old Central Library documents containing 26 lakhs pages. Up till now we have received 102 DVDs and metadata of that digitized documents are being made. For the convenience of the library users this information is available in library home page. CDAC, Kolkata the operator of this project has completed their first phase work and they will start the second phase work at any time. Question papers of 2005-06 have already been digitized.
