Visva-Bharati Library Network

The origin of Visva-Bharati Library Network is traced back to Rabindranath Tagore starting a college (Visva-Bharati) in Santiniketan in the year 1921 with the proceedings of the Nobel Prize he won in 1913. The Library was developed and enriched with great care by Gurudev himself. On his death in 1941, his personal collection was added to this library.

Currently, the Library Network comprises of the Central Library, 13 Sectional (Bhavana) Libraries and 30 Seminar Libraries. All the libraries in the system are fully automated and networked. Though located at various places in the two campuses, they function virtually as a single unit.

Due to corona outbreak, during this period library services in physical mode was totally closed as the education institutions are not allowed to function in normal course. Therefore the online service was the only way to cater library services. The need of Remote Access (Open Athens) & Discovery Services for accessing of e-resources was prerequisite to serve its clientele. In addition to continuation of existing activities (out of which arrangement of books in the stack, Reference Archives, Up-to-date Book Processing and print out of Accession Register, are a few to notable) and services, following steps have been taken by the VBLN to address the needs of the academic community:

Creation of WhatsApp group; Telegram group; Library facebook; YouTube Channel; tabulating the Open Access Educational Resources and disseminate through different channels (e-mail, university website, library website, WhatsApp, etc. etc.); organization of webinar (Research Methodology, special sessions on Plagiarism Checking, Remote Access & Discovery Services, Open Access Resources, Research Tools, Library Resources & Services etc.) to keep update the academic fraternities by using Cisco WebEx, Zoom, Google Meet, etc.; arranged online demonstration program on e-resources, Research Tools (like Grammarly, RAxter) LSDiscovery (which VBLN is planning to subscribe for its unlimited access and single window search in place of existing Open Athens (Discovery services) for limited users and facilities; organized hands-on training program for registration in Vidwan and IRINS (Indian Research Information Network System) databases (it is to be noted that before September 2020 Visva-Bharati fraternity does not have registration, but now we are third among the Central Universities); extending co-operation to the academic departments for online PhD final viva, BoS meeting, Pre-submission seminar of the scholars, etc.; extend co-operation to the university administration for arranging online meeting, VB Lecture Series and Young Scholar Series in online mode, observation of different days like Librarians' Day, Library Day, Yoga Day, Constitution Day, Womens' Day, Vigilance Awareness week, etc.

Prepare the AQAR and SSR based on last five years date i.e. from 2015-16 to 2019-20 has also been done properly for the visit of NAAC peer team.

QR code on library services and resources has been updated to encourage the users' community to use the library in fewer headaches.

URKUND anti-plagiarism software for checking of similarity/significance for thesis and other publications is being done with several awareness programs.

The Central Library remains open all days of the year except few holidays viz., Republic Day, Independence Day and Gandhi Jayanti, Poush Utsav, Basantotsav, Gandhi Punyaha, Saradobakash, Poush Mela, etc.

Total no. of days Library was open in the year: 192 days (Lockdown 106 days, Weekly Holidays - 33 and other Holidays -34).

b) Sectional Libraries: Most of them are open during 9.30 am – 6pm, weekly off days are Saturday and Sunday while the same is Wednesday and Sunday for Rabindra Bhavana and Patha Bhavana Library (service hour 6.30am to 1.00pm).

16. Library Automation:

Visva-Bharati Library is connected with the Campus- wide Fiber Optic Network named GitanjaliNet (INFLIBNET). Library system has 171 PCs, 59 printers including 22 barcode printers, 05 web camera, 01 digital camera, 03 LCD Projectors at its Central Library and 12 Sectional Libraries. Library offers services and facilities of browsing e-journals, online-databases, e-books to its users. On-line searching, e-mail facilities for academic and research purposes, etc. have also been provided by the Library.

Library Management Software LibSys-7 (Unicode Web compliant) is being used for automating the library activity and services. All daily library operations and services i.e. Acquisition of library documents, Cataloguing, Serial control, Circulation, OPAC, L-Search Mobile Apps, e-mail alert on overdue books etc. are going on smoothly on this Library Management Software. Library catalogue database covering almost total holdings of Central Library, other Sectional Libraries and GranthanVibhaga are accessible now on Intranet (http://172.16.2.2:8380/opac/) / Internet (http://14.139.211.2:8380/opac/)

Presently, Visva-Bharati Library catalogue database holds 5,92,947 titles of documents containing 7,84,586 individual accession numbers including 48,417 bound volumes of journals and 2,859 theses and purchased e-books (6969). In addition, purchased e-book (perpetual mode) 1,15,000—titles through various consortia) from world famous publishers/aggregators (Elsevier, Cambridge Online, Springer, Sage, Taylor & Francis, Oxford University Press and British Council Library) which have been linked (alphabetical, subject-wise, publisher-wise) in the library web page for browsing from the campus.

Central Library has made an **Institutional Repository** of syllabuses of various courses. Question papers of different examinations held at Visva-Bharati since 2007 are also added to this Institutional Repository. These question papers / syllabuses can be accessed, downloaded and/or printed over the Campus Network through Central Library web page. This **Institutional Repository** is being regularly used bythe library members. The Visva-Bharati Library invites its faculty members and research scholars to upload their publications in Institutional Repository (*Open Archive*) and encourages others to browse such publications. The Open Archive now contains near about 156 articles of faculties.
