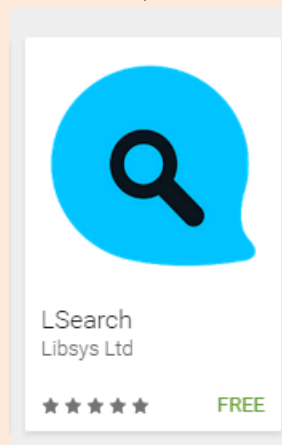
Library WebOPAC goes Mobile Compliant: Carry the Library in Your Palm!

You no longer need a computer to search books/journals or to check your library account. Now onwards it can be done from your smartphone (Android).

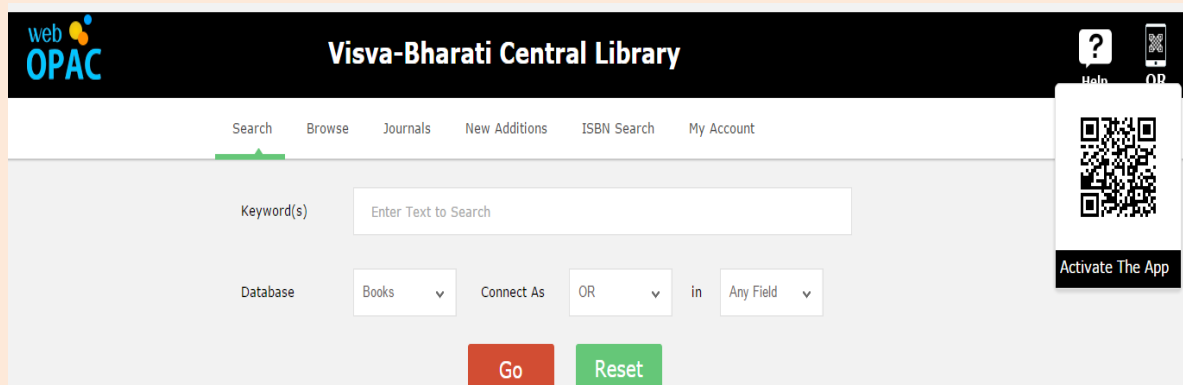
LSearch is an App providing access to your library OPAC on the fly. The App directly connects your device to your library server for real time information retrieval. The smartly designed interface gives a joyful library experience. LSearch App on your mobile device provides a quick, efficient and portable way of remaining connected to the library.

1. Download LSearch App from 'Play Store' and install it in your mobile.

(Play Store → APPS → Search → lsearch → Install → Accept. 'Open' will appear on your device)



2. Scan QR Code from <http://172.16.2.2:8380/opac/>
(Go to any machine within campus, click on <http://172.16.2.2:8380/opac/>, put mouse point on QR → keep the camera of your phone in line of sight of QR code → touch on ‘Scan QR Code to get started’ at bottom of mobile → see the QR code turning green which signifies activation (a one-time process).

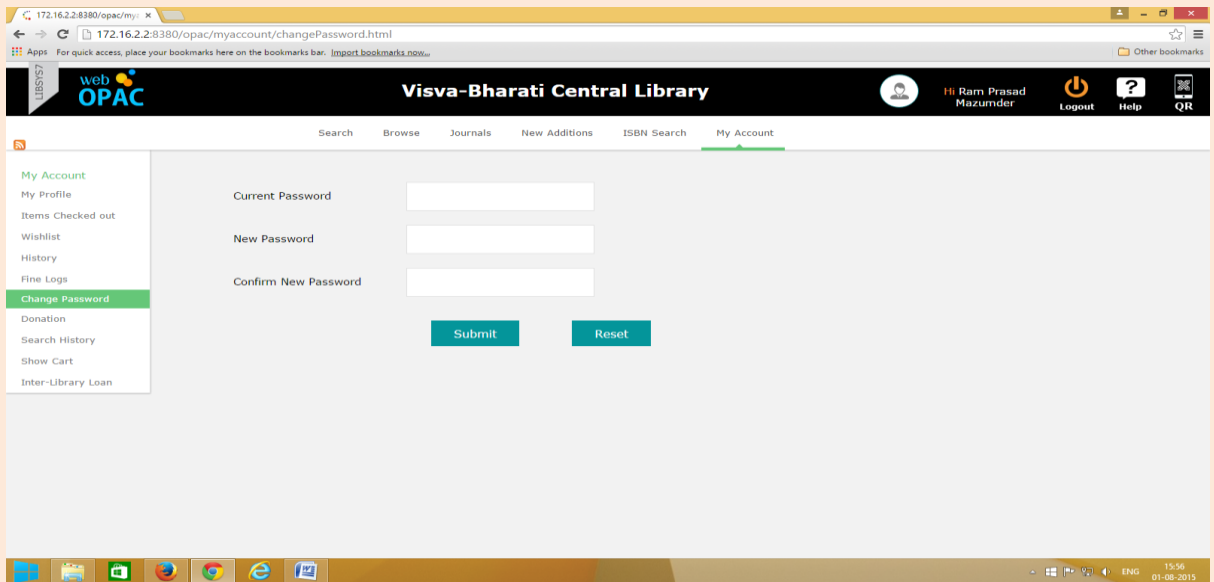


2. Browse and search book/ journal databases, besides see your account (check-out), change your password... (Remember to ‘log out’).
3. In case of problem in installation, approach the Sectional Library/ Central Library



NB: While you need Internet connectivity in your mobile to install the App, it's not required later to browse the databases but from the campus. If you wish to access the WebOPAC from outside the campus, click here <http://14.139.211.2:8080/jopacgw/GwtOPAC/GwtOPAC.html>.

1. Default Password: By default every member's pass word is: vbu123 (User Name will be one's Library Card No.) Change your password **immediately**. (Watch your account, change profile...)

How do I get photocopying, printing, scanning, spiral, lamination services within the Library?

Central Library

Photocopying, printing, scanning, spiral, lamination services: These services are out-sourced. These may be availed on spot payment to the vendors stationed at the Library at the rate negotiated and fixed by the University and displayed.

'Scan it Yourself': The facility to scan by oneself (free) is also provided for, at the Periodical Section.

Sectional Libraries

Photocopying: The facility is available and is outsourced at Cheena & Hindi Bhavana Libraries.

Some Recent Library Activities / Developments

- **Three - day Intensive Workshop on Personality Development and Communication Skill:** The workshop on *Personality Development and Communication Skill* was organised in Central Library, Visva-Bharati, during 23 – 25 July 2015, jointly with IASLIC (Indian Association of Special Libraries and Information Centres), Kolkata for the benefit of the staff of the VB Library Network. The workshop was attended by 29 participants. (A repeat programme will be held in September for the remainder employees of the Network) The workshop was coordinated by Sri. Sujit Kujur and Dr. Sanat Bhattacharya, Assistant Librarians.

The workshop, conducted in 11 technical sessions over three days, aimed at developing Personality, Self Management Practices, Oral Communication, Written Communication, Presentation Skill and Listening Skill. The main thread of the workshop was development of the information professionals in an other - than technical dimension like team work, leadership, motivation, goal setting etc.

The workshop was inaugurated by Prof. Swapan Kumar Datta, Pro-Vice Chancellor, Visva-Bharati (after lighting of the lamp) wherein he spoke of the importance offering prompt and courteous service to the users. Dr. V. K. Thomas, University Librarian welcomed the gathering. Prof. S. B. Banerjee, Vice-President, IASLIC, Prof. K. P. Majumder, Convener, Education Division, IASLIC and Dr J. N. Satpathi, former President, IASLIC spoke on the importance of and various components of the workshop.

The workshop began with a lecture on **Written Communication** by Prof. Goutam Sengupta, retired Professor, Gurudas College, Kolkata and a Management Educator. He trained the participants through practical ways on report writing, notice writing, note making of meetings, resolutions etc.

Day 2 had Smt. Soma Mukherjee, Management Educator and Consultant, DISHA Academy as the resource person. The first part was on **Oral Communication**. She used interactive learning methods to train participants with the objective that they would be able to adapt and apply the newly acquired skill in near future. The afternoon was devoted to Presentation Skill. The workshop included lectures, discussions, role playing and hands-on on basic skills training.

The third day of the workshop started with the lecture on **Personality Development and Self Management Practices** by Smt. Barnali Roy Choudhury, Management Consultant, Kolkata. She taught dimensions of personality, communication style, developing of positive attitude and self confidence. She dwelt also on **Listening Skill** and smarter goals.

The Workshop ended in the evening with the concluding session with a speech and distribution of certificates by Dr. D. Gunasekaran, Registrar, Visva-Bharati. He spoke elaborately on the importance of skill development for better productivity of human resource. (*photo in the last page*)

- **LibSys Training Programme:** Central Library has organized jointly with LibSys Corporation, Kolkata, an one - day training programme on Migration version of LibSys for the Library Staff on 28 July 2015. It was done in 2 batches to accommodate all staff without disrupting the services. The timings were: 11.00 am to 1.00 pm and 3.00 pm to 5.00 pm.
