GERMAN CERTIFICATE COURSE

Paper I: Translation and Textual Analysis

Objective: Developing basic translation skills and basic comprehension of German texts corresponding to A2 level of CEFR.

Learning outcome: Learners should be able to comprehend and analyze the content of basic texts in German. Learners should be able to translate simple texts from German into English. Level A2 of CEFR.

Paper II: Grammar and Composition

Objective: Developing knowledge of basic German Grammar up to the use of Konjunktiv II. Ability to express oneself in creative passages and texts (letters, compositions, dialogues etc.). A2 level of CEFR.

Learning outcome: Students should be able to construct grammatically correct sentences in written form, using complex syntactical structures like Nebensatz, Relativsatz, zu+Infinity-Satz, using basic Tempi and Konjunktiv II. A2 level of CEFR.

Paper III: Oral

Objective: Developing ability to express oneself orally on typical topics and in typical situation using vocabulary and grammar corresponding to A2 level of CEFR.

Learning outcome: Developing basic communication skills in face-to-face personal interaction; basic oral commentary on typical given situations. A2 level of CEFR.
