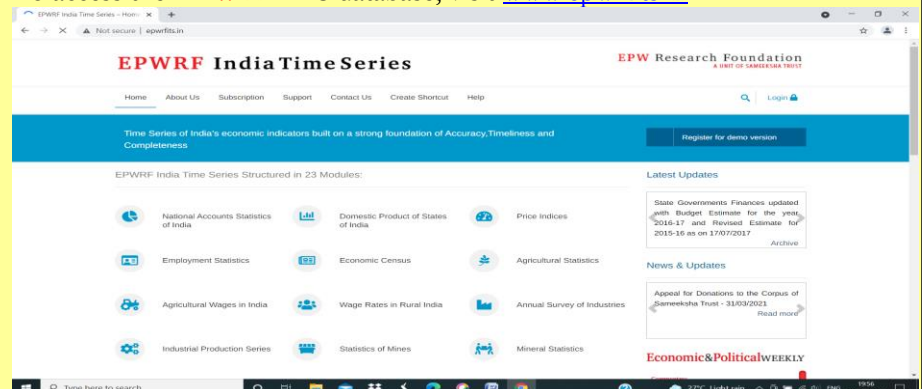

EPWRFIndia Time Series

An Online Database on Indian Economy and Society built on the Core Values of *Accuracy, Timeliness and Completeness*

The **EPWRFIndia Times Series (EPWRFITS)** (www.epwrfits.in), is an interactive renewal basis online database purchased during couple of years. This may also be accessible through remote access i.e. LSDiscovery (<https://vbu.lsdiscovery.in/>).

Economic & Political Weekly Research Foundation (EPWRF): Established in 1993, EPWRF is a constituent unit of Sameeksha Trust, which also publishes the reputed social science journal, **Economic & Political Weekly (EPW)**.

The **EPWRFIndia Times Series (EPWRFITS)**, interactive online database launched in 2011, is developed and administered by the EPW Research Foundation (EPWRF) with an aim to provide time series data on the Indian economy for facilitating economic analysis.

EPWRF India Time Series is a unique online database with its comprehensive coverage of Indian economy for a fairly long time period and it comprises over a lakh variables capsuled in 27 modules. The database tries to provide in continuous time series from 1950 depending on the availability.

The **EPWRF ITS** database provides a wide range of macro-economic, financial and social statistics in a time series format and has over 55,000 variables structured in 23 different subject modules, of which 16 modules have state-wise data series, and Banking Statistics module has data sets for 722 districts.

The data has been collated from diverse official publications such as Reserve Bank of India, National Statistical Office, Government departments, and so on. Depending upon availability, data series starts from as early as 1950s. The data tables of all modules are updated timely, as and when data are released depending upon the frequency.

Key Features of EPWRF ITS database

Key Features	Description
Time Series Data	Data are made available in time-series format
Data updated timely	As and when data are released, they are updated depending upon the frequency of their release – weekly, fortnightly, monthly, quarterly and yearly
Export data to MS-Excel	In-built facilities to export the retrieved data set to an Excel spreadsheet
Module description	Description has been provided in every module that helps the users to get an idea about the entire module and also a particular section. Definitions of major concepts and terms used in the respective sections and sub-section. Description of the conceptual and methodological issues are provided, when required.
Ease of variable selection	Data series are arranged in a thematic format and presented under various sections. Users can select variables of their choice from same or different sub-sections and accordingly generate tables making it more user-friendly. For instance, in <i>Banking Statistics</i> module the data sets are classified under 'All India', 'State-wise' and 'District-wise' category. Users have the choice of selecting states, districts and variables of their choice and cull out data accordingly, which saves time for compilation.

This database may be accessed through both a) IP address as institutional member and b) Remote Access.

a) Access through IP address as institutional member:

First step is to login to your account using home page login section. For institution type, users are not required to add username and password.

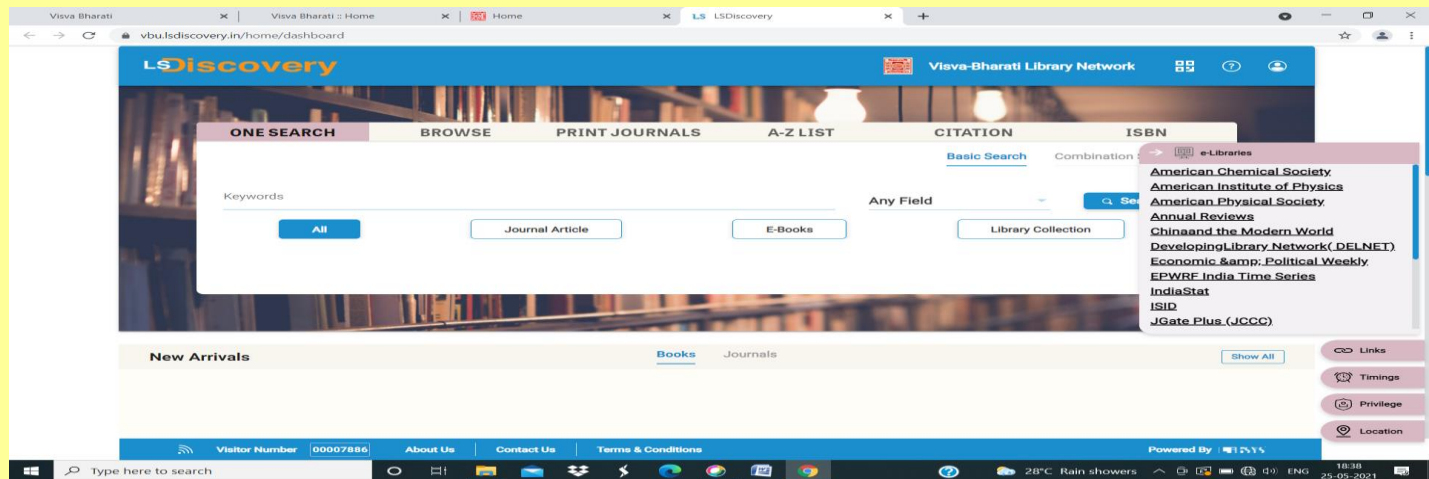
b) Access through Remote Access: The EPWRF India Times Series also accessible through remote access (LsDiscovery), only requirement is to login of remote access by using Library Card No. as ID & vbu123 as password.

There are two ways to reach the above database

i) Click the link <https://vbu.lsdisccovery.in/home/dashboard> then click e-Libraries, and finally click EPWRFITS; or

ii) Click the link <https://visva-bharati-library.in> then click LSDiscovery with OPAC, then click e-Libraries, and finally click EPWRFITS; or

iii) Click the link www.visvabharati.ac.in/index.html then click Library then click LSDiscovery with OPAC, then click e-Libraries, and finally click EPWRFITS.



Accessibility of Grammarly:

One-time Self-Registration Process as given below to access Grammarly;

A. Having VB domain mail ID (xxx.yyy@visva-bharati.ac.in)

Step 1: Go to www.grammarly.com/edu (mandatory to sign up for this URL)

Step 2: Click on Join Your Organization button, fill up the self-service form. Ensure that users are registering from their respective official email id (@visva-bharati.ac.in)

Step 3: After clicking signup, an activation email will be sent to the user's institutional email ID.

Please Note: Your @edu credential verification has been activated and an activation email will be sent to the user's institutional email ID once he/she registers. Users may at times get this in Spam/Junk/Promotion/Update Folder due to mail setting - users are advised to check the spam folder in case the link is not received in the INBOX.

Step 4: Kindly Verify the activation mail from Grammarly. Once registered, users will land on the 'Grammarly Editor', which is easy to use and can be explored by the user. The MS Word Plugin can be downloaded from the support page after registration from the link: <https://www.grammarly.com/office-addin/windows>, the same user ID and Password credentials will grant access to use the Plugin for users.

Step 5: Kindly use access code: 'riyCsWRtFoazgotP' for registration.

- **Three-Day Demonstration Program on E-Resources:** Central Library, Visva-Bharati, has organized a Three-day demo program on e-resources by different publishers in virtual mode during 16-18 August 2023. Twenty-six (26) reputed National and International level publishers have demonstrated their e-resources on respective platforms. Total 41, 30 and 25 number of participants have witnessed the each of the three-day respectively. The sessions were arranged to comply with the standard Operating Procedure for procurement of e-resources by VBLN and to give the academics an ambiance regarding the collection and development of the e-resources of different world-class publishers.

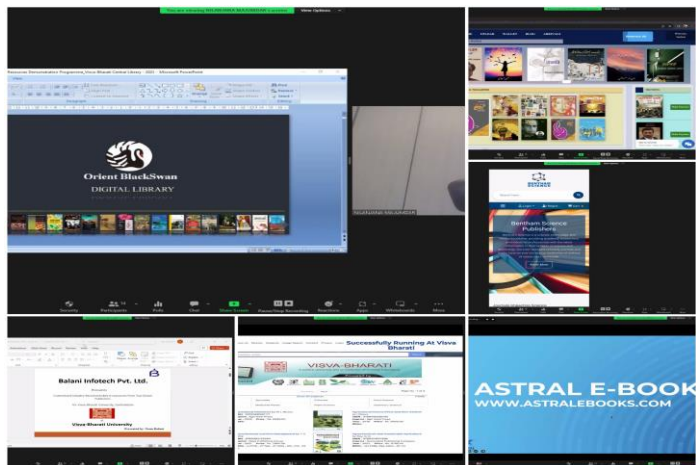
