Exclude & Include Sources Options:

User can exclude and include sources if the sources are irrelevant to the subject or users own work

Exclude: Select the sources from the matched source list and click on “Exclude” button. Include: Select the sources from the excluded sources list and click on “Include” button. Alternate Sources

The same content may be available in single source or multiple sources, but the software will detect all the sources and display the highest percentage in the primary source and others are in alternate source list.

Matched Sources Navigation:

User can click on the source, and it will navigate to matched content in the document. Click on the “NEXT HIGHLIGHT” to view the next matched content in the same page or different pages.

Click on the “PREVIOUS HIGHLIGHT” to view the previous matched content in the same page or different pages.

Matched Content Navigation:

User can check the matched source from the matched content by clicking on the highlighted color. The matched source will be highlighted in the sources list.

Hotels and restaurants have been mostly affected due to pandemic and national wide lockdown to cut the virus from spreading. The size of Indian restaurant industry is of worth \$ 30 billion in 2020. COVID-19 (SARS-CoV-2) belongs to a large group of corona virus family which causes severe respiratory illness. The first outbreak of corona virus is from the Wuhan city, located in the Hubei province, China in December 2019 and further World Health Organization (WHO) officially declared it as a pandemic. This spread of the corona pandemic, along with human health and wealth, also affected the food sector globally with various reports of food workers all over the world getting infected by transmission of the virus through the consumption of meat and poultry products. Compared to food industry to other industry, workers do not have the opportunity 'work from home and are required to work in their usual workplaces. Germination of seed is considered as the most significant step for determining the success or debacle of crop establishment. Field crops are extremely sensitive to chilling particularly during germination and early phases of seedling development. Each seed requires optimum temperature for germination which confer seeds to generate healthy seedling. But due to extreme temperature, the normal germination indices and growth can be affected (Hussain et al., 2018). In the present study, chilling stress caused a considerable reduction of germination percentage especially under prolong chilling condition. Previously, several studies have documented the delayed and non-uniform germination of rice under chilling stress (da Cruz and Mitach, 2004; Ye et al., 2009). Chilling stress is known to thermodynamically limit the kinetics of various physiological as well as metabolic functions in plants (Rustland et al., 2009) which finally evokes a detrimental effect on germination indices of rice seeds. Our results depict 9 % reduction in the seed germination at
