 4. Give an account of Sāṃkhya theory of causation. How do the Sāṃkhya philosophers refute *asatkāryavāda*. 10+5=15
 5. Explain the nature of *sāmānya* as a category after Vaiśeṣika philosophy. Discuss the various types of *jātibādhaka*. 6+9=15
 6. What is *cittavṛtti* according to Yoga Philosophy? What are the different types of *cittavṛtti*? Explain the eightfold means of Yoga. 2+3+10=15
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
