 4. Explain Hume's scepticism and distinguish it from Descartes' notion of scepticism. 10+5=15
 5. Distinguish after Kant, between analytic and synthetic statements. 15
 6. Write short notes on **any two** of the following: 7.5+7.5=15
 - (a) Kant's concept of synthetic a-priori judgement.
