INSTITUTIONAL REPOSITORY OF VISVA BHARATI: NEW LOOK OF WEB INTERFACE THROUGH JOOMLA

Background: Although the web page of Institutional Repository for Visva Bharati has been created long back but that was merely a template & non-interactive webpage designed in HTML. Institutional Repository (IR) of Visva Bharati faculty, staff & scholars has been actually started since 2011, when research publications have been shared to library for upload on Visva-Bharati website. The new interface through joomla has been implemented in the month of April 2017 with different types of functionalities and search interface. In the latest updates users can freely truncate their search term by different types of search terms like title, type of publication, author, year of publication, bhavana/subject/research etc.

Aim of this IR: Authors may get citation based on the details of the original publication without hampering copyright issues. For this the download of full text outside the campus is being restricted but, they can visualize the bibliographic details of the same. Sometimes, VB fraternity may not be aware about some publications of his/her VB colleagues & scholars and for which they need to pay to the publishers or else to have the accessibility of the full text of one particular publication. This initiative may remove that kind of limitation and indirectly enhance the interdisciplinary research. Thus, it is helpful to both author/contributor of the publication as well as colleagues & scholars of VB being users.

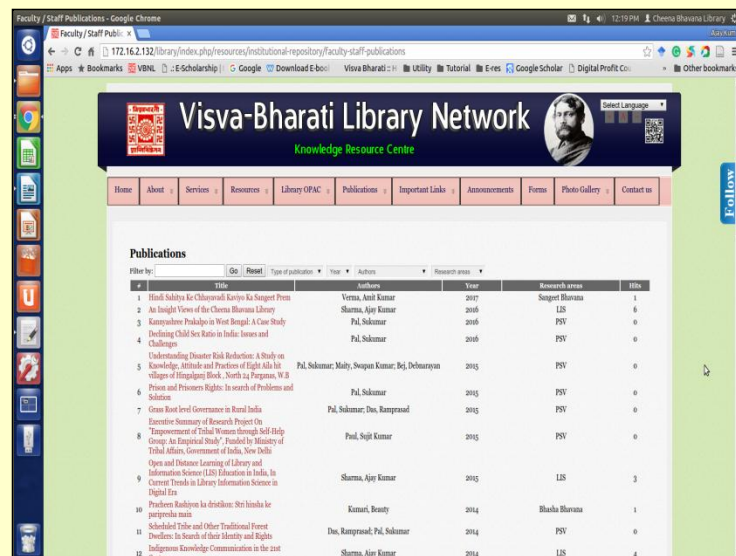


Fig. 1: Layout of IR Interface

Coverage: It covers the publications of faculty, staff or research scholar of Visva-Bharati fraternity. Its publications vary from journal articles, books, book chapters, proceedings, thesis, patents, technical reports, etc.

Accessibility: Though the new interface of IR with all bibliographic details is accessible globally but access of its full text is restricted within the Visva-Bharati University Campus (Computers using Visva-Bharati Networking – controlled by Computer Centre).

Features: Some distinctive attributes have been implemented in this new interface of Institutional Repository. All the publications may get numbers of hits for its full text access and this feature may be helpful to users to get the right paper at right time easily and quickly from this IR.

a. **Title Search / filter:** Users may search / filter with any text from the title of the documents. Search term may entered and press to go button, it matches the term given with the entered titles of the documents and gives the result irrespective of years and type of publications.

b. **Filter by Type of Publications:** Users may filter all the publications with its publications type likewise journal articles, books, book chapters, proceedings, thesis, patents, technical reports, etc. Users may get selected type of publications at one place irrespective of years, authors and research areas.

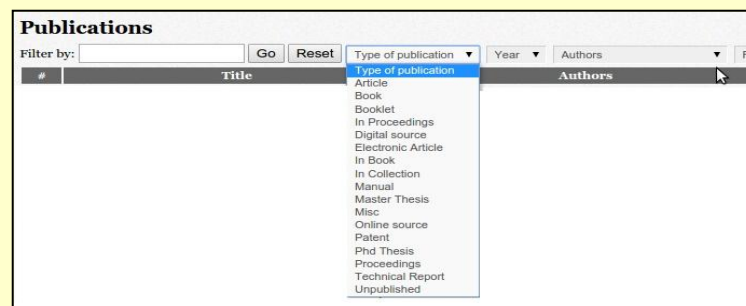


Fig. 3: Filter by Type of Publications

c. **Filter by year of publications:** Users may filter / sort all the publications with its publications year, in other words users may get selected years of publications at one place irrespective of types, authors and research areas.

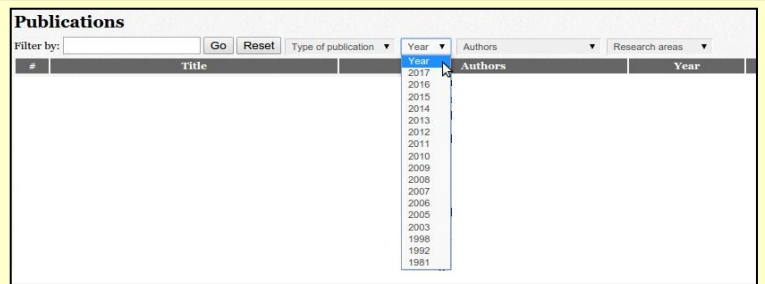


Fig. 4: Filter by Year of Publications

d. **Filter by author of publications:** Users have also the facility to filter all the publications with its author, means same author publications may get at one place irrespective of type, years and research areas. Author from the outside Visva- Bharati can also be browsed through this functionality in case of joint authorship with Visva- Bharati fraternity.

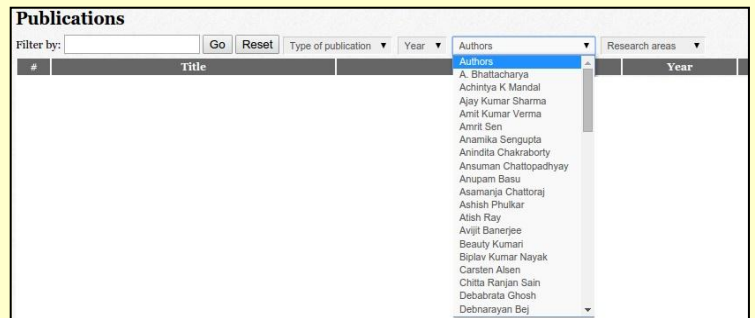


Fig. 5: Filter by Author

e. **Filter by research areas:** Research areas indicate the Bhavana / department of Visva- Bharati of the concerned author (based on first author of the publication). Users may filter / sort all the publications of same Bhavana at one place irrespective of types, authors and year of publications.

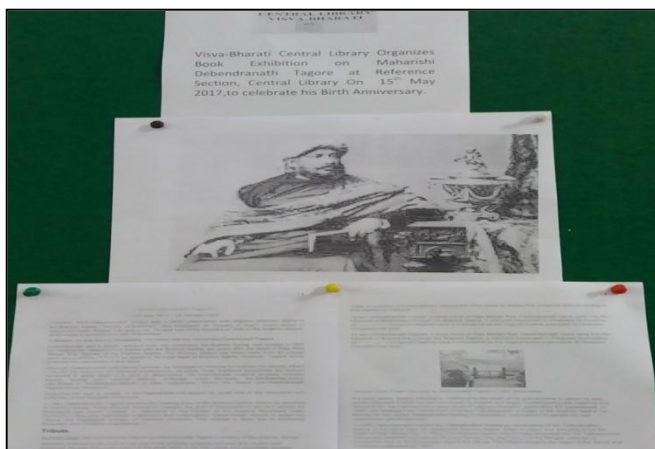
