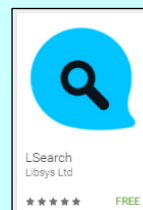

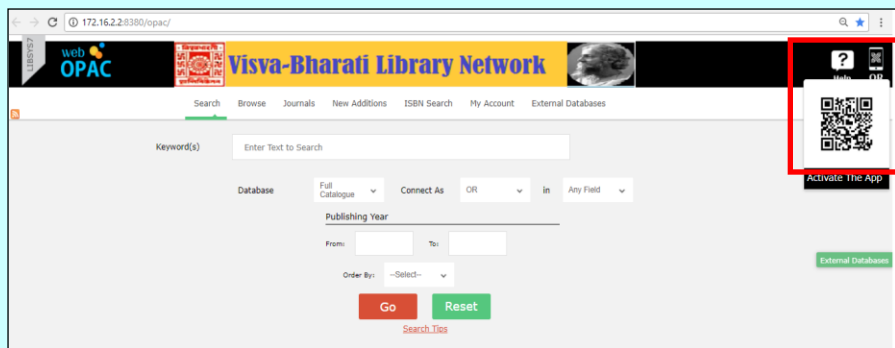
LIBRARY WEBOPAC GOES MOBILE COMPLIANT: CARRY THE LIBRARY IN YOUR PALM!

Users' no longer need a computer to search books/journals or to check library account. Now it can be done through smartphone (Android) of the individual user. LSearch is an App providing access to Visva-Bharati library OPAC on the fly. The App directly connects the device to library server for real time information retrieval. The smartly designed interface gives a joyful library experience. LSearch App on mobile device provides a quick, efficient, portable and friendly way of remaining connected with the Visva-Bharati library.

1. Download LSearch App from 'Play Store' and install it in your mobile.
(Play Store → APPS → Search → lsearch → Install → Accept. 'Open' will appear on your device)



2. Scan QR Code from <http://172.16.2.2:8380/opac/>
(Go to any machine within campus, click on <http://172.16.2.2:8380/opac/>, put mouse point on QR → keep the camera of your phone in line of sight of QR code → touch on 'Scan QR Code to get started' at bottom of mobile → see the QR code turning green which signifies activation (a one-time process).

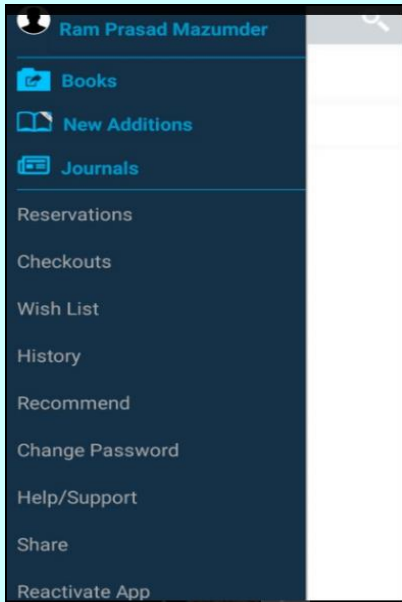

App Display



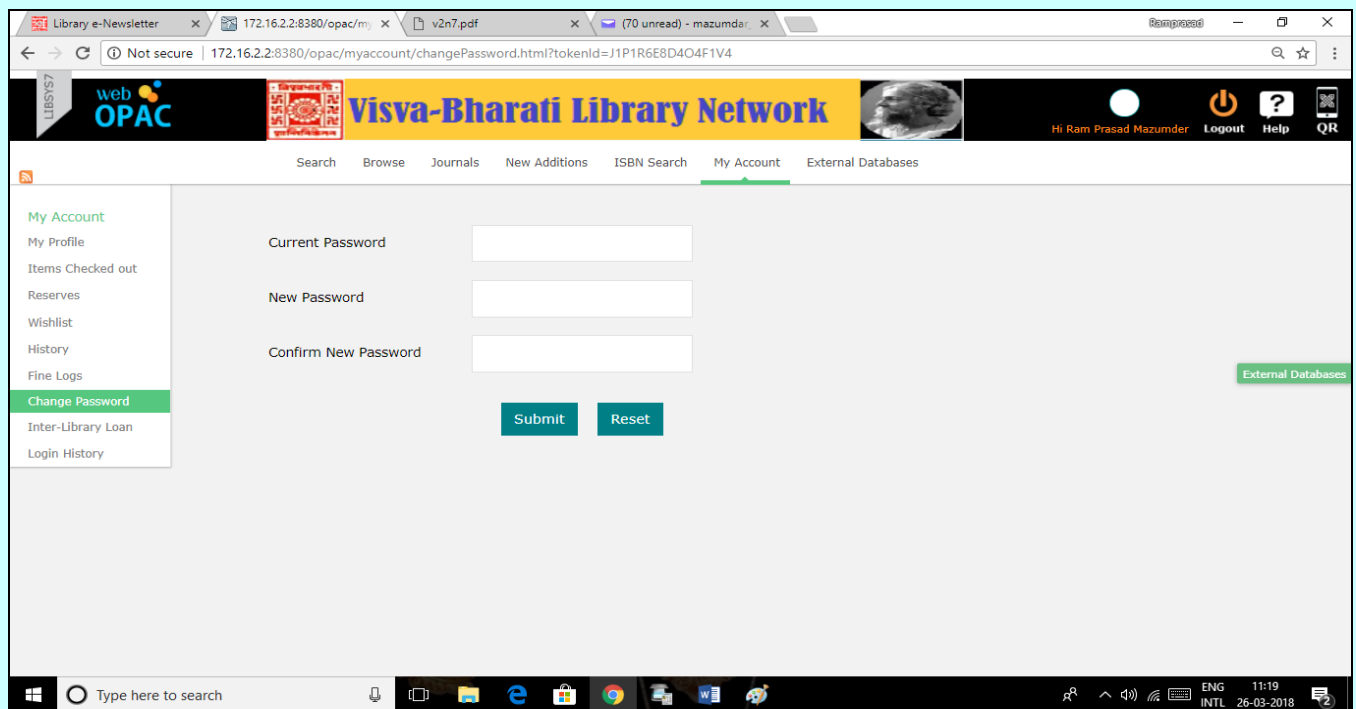
Book Display
